

Monthwar Activities, Projects done by the Club (2007-08)

On behalf of the President, Ln Shiv Jeyaram Sharma & Members of our prestigious club, We take pride in submitting the Report on our Activities accomplished during the current Golden Jubilee Lionistic Year 2007-08.

We take immense pleasurer to record that right from the day one of the Lionistic year, the Club has been doing excellently well in all aspects. Herebelow are the highlights of our Clubs' activities monthwar.

July 2007:

During the month of July 2007 more than a Dozen of projects had been accomplished worth over Rs.70000/-. To highlight a few,

Eye Screening Camps:(Governor's Thrust Area)

The Installation day recorded an Eye Screening camp over 100 were benefited through the same. Around 8 people were given Cateract Surgery at a Cost of Rs. 26000/-.

Mega Health Camp:

On the 1st July, our club had conducted a Mega Ayurvedic Medical camp exclusively for Lion members of our Region and also for General Public. Around 85 people were benefited at a cost of Rs.15000/-

Educational & Uniforms distribution:

On the 16th July, around 87 Students of our Adopted Rangarajapuram Corporation School have been provided the Uniform Sets and it was a Project in which all the Clubs in our Region I Blue Sapphire participated and the Governor PMJF Ln Govindasamy Thangaraj distributed the Uniform sets. Project initiated by Lions Club of T Nagar with a contribution of Rs.7500/- Lion K Ravikumar donated Rs.5000/- and Lion S J Sharma donated Rs.2500/-

On the same day, Lion MJF T N Kumar and Lion K Ravikumar donated Rs.2700/- towards School Fees of a Child of a Aids Affected person.

Blood Donation Camps:

Two Blood Donation camps were organized on the 16th of July 2007 and 25th July 2007 @ Kalamandir Matriculation Hr Sec. School, West Mambalam, Ln T Selvakumar played a vital role by sponsoring his crew for 25 Units of Blood and provision of snacks and biscuits for the donors and One At a Software Company in Shenoy Nagar Aound 83 units of Blood procured safe by the Lions Club Blood Bank, Egmore. The total cost of the projects was Rs.4000/-.

August 2007:

Eye Screening Camps:

A Mega eye Screening Camp organized by our Ln T N Kumar at Pollachi, Childrens Park along with Lions Club of Pollachi and over 250 were screened and around 33 people were given cateract surgery at a Cost of over Rs.1,00,000/-. For which the club was awarded Par Excellence.

Dine with Divine:

Around 17000 people were given a meal each by our Lion A S Rajasekhar at Siruvachur Madura Kalamman Temple near Perambalur at a cost of over Rs.5 Lakhs. Sponsored by Lion A S Rajashekar.

Health & Dental Camp:

A mega dental and health camp organized by our Club for the students of Kalamandir Matriculation School, West Mambalam, Chennai 33 and around 450 students were benefited. The Project done jointly with SRM Hospitals, West Mambalam, Chennai 600 033. The project cost around Rs.25000/-.

Independence Day Celeberations:

For the First time in Club's History, we Celebrated Independence Day with a project of donating Utencils to Anganwadi School, KK Nagar, Chennai 78, after Flat hoisting at our Lions Hospital. The Total cost of the Project was Rs.2500/-.

Educational Assistance:

The Club has donated Rs.1500/- to Lions District 324 B2 towards District Educational Project on 19th August 2007 during Inter District Inter Club Meeting with Lions Club of Salem Mid Town.

September 2007:

Eye Screening Camp 0:

On 23rd September 2007, an Eye Screening Camp organized by us at Kalamandir Matriculation Hr Sec. School, West Mambalam, Chennai 33 and nearly 60 people were benefited and screened and around 8 underwent cataract surgery. It was organized alongwith Saradha Eye Care Clinic, West Mambalam, Chennai 600 033. The Total Project Cost is Rs.26000/-

Dine with Divine:

As part of the Celebrations of PDG PMJF Ln. R MOHAN, the club had contirbuted Rs.1000/- towards Dine With Divine Project arranged by the Region Chairman Ln MJF Jayashri Mohanasundaram. The Beneficiaries were inmates of the Andhra Mahila Sabha on the 15th of September 2007.

October 2007:

Ayurvedic Medical Camp:

On 2nd October 2007, an Ayurvedic Medical Camp conducted by us at Shree Seva Mandir, Sayee Nagar, Virugambakkam, Chennai 600 092 and nearly 100 people were given treatment and medicines worth Rs.15000/- were distributed free of cost to the patients. Around 60% were benefited from the Seva Mandir and rest general public. Lion M Muralidharan was the main man behind the same.

World Service Day:

On 8th of October 2007, the Club had registered its participation in the Diabetes Awareness Camp organized by the Region Chairman MJF Ln Jayashri Mohanasundaram. The Contribution was Rs.500/-.

On the same day, Utencils worth over Rs.2500/- were distributed to the inmates of BVSN Murthy Centre for Special Children, West Mambalam, Chennai 600 033.

Educational Projects:

May 2008

Only 30 took consultations with our Doctors and it was a maiden attempt of a free camp in such society.

No Tobacco Day:

May 31st every year is celebrated as WORD NO TOBACCO DAY and we also celebrated the same with an awareness project at Sri Ramakrishna Mission Higher Secondary School Campus on the said date and inside Jeeva Park Also. The team carried a banner STOP SMOKING AND CHEWING TOBACCO for a Healthier Breath.

The team also had about 1000 pamphlets a copy of which is separately attached in another mail. The leaflets contained information on Quick tips to get rid of smoking habits, psychological effects of smoking and damages caused by such smoking are narrated with an advertisement of our hospital photo.

Our Chief Guest, District Governor, PMJF Lion Govindasamy Thangaraj inaugurated the Project. A White Cap embossed with the International Lion Emblem with Lions club of T.Nagar Name was distributed to the students and other lion members who participated including the Governor. Governor praised the Students for their effective participation. The total cost of the Project is around Rs.3000/- plus.

Heart Surgery:

June 2008

World Environment Day:

The President and Secretary participated in the Tree Plantation Project on the June 5th. An Information about the Campaign was kept displayed near the Gate by the School. The Trees Planted inside the Campus of Sri Ramakrishna Mission Higher Secondary School, Main Branch, T Nagar, Chennai 600 017. The Headmaster, Mr G Chandran and The Asst. Head Master Mr. Thiagaraja Pillai and his PG Assistants and all 12th Standard Students have participated in the plantation. Prior to the plantation, The Headmaster Mr G Chandran welcomed us and thanked us for initiation such an useful project on this day, and also recollected with respect, our president's services to the school when he was a Teacher. President delivered his speech on the World Environment Day in the main hall and over 150 Students were attended the meeting.

Diabetic Detection Project:

Age group From 25 to 39 - 16 Persons (One Found Low Sugar)

Dr Ilangovan with dedication given the counselling and advised them according to their Sugar Levels and also prescribed for General Care Take. The Project details pamphlets for the 15th June 2008 Ayurvedic Free Medical camp were also distributed in the Branch to customers. Many customers were curious about the Ayurvedic Approach. A Senior Officer Mrs. Subha and Branch Manger of the Branch were fully onto knowing about Ayurvedic Concepts. Friends, wherever we go and whatever we do, we try to create an awareness about our Lions Ayurvedic Hospital and Ayurvedic Concepts by and large.

The Cost of this Project is Rs.4000/- The Branch has made arrangements for provision of Tea, Coffee and Snacks & Biscuits to the Lions, Staffs and Customers. The One Touch Sugar level Identifier Strips in Digital Checker were purchased around 75 nos. for the Project.

Individual Cataract Patients Referrals:

Other than the above, President & Secretary had sent over 15 acute Cataract related patients to Kims Lions Eye Hospital and Sankaran Nethralaya over a period of time.

Golden Jubilee Project – RO Water Treatment Plant:

(Continious Projects – Corporation School at Rangarajapuram, Ch)

On the 13th of December 2007, foundation stone has been laid by the Councilor, Mr K S Mani, District Governor, PMJF Ln Govindasamy Thangaraj and the President of the Club with Secretary & Treasurer. The Club had already paid the margin money towards the Project Cost – Rs.50000/- to the District. Out of Rs.50000/-, Rs.10000/- donated by Ln S Balasubramaniam & Lion T Selvakumar. The Club had also remitted Rs.20000/- to the District as a Refundable amount on account of RO Water Treatment Plant. The President, Ln S J Sharma on his Herculean Efforts made the Corporation of Chennai to participate in the RO Plant erection and had arranged the construction of base infrastructure at a cost of over Rs.1.25 lakh and will be commissioned on the Monday, 30th June 2008 by Shri Ma. Subramaniam, Worshipful Mayor, Chennai. This will be a Second Permenant Project of the Club. Those who had donated liberally for the Project a list is separately attached in the Excel Work Sheet. Two image building plaque is also to be unveiled.

Hundreds of patients are given treatment at our Lions Ayurvedic Hospital, 95th Street, KK Nagar, Chennai 600 078 and nearly Rs.25000/- worth medicines are freely distributed every month. The hospital is open between 9AM and 1 PM and recently from December 1st, we have opened the evening session from 5 PM to 7 PM with Dr. Elangovan. After Dr Archana leaving the Hospital, Dr Ilangovan took over as in-charge for the whole day. We appreciate and sincerely thank his good gesture. Also accredit our thanks to Lion Dr Veerachozhan who continuously sending inpatients to the Hospital for treatment. Needless to say Ln M Muralidharan had played a vital role in making generic medicines and sales of the same.

A Lions' share goes to our President, Ln S J Sharma in the hospital bringing up with image built and series of advertisements arranged in the local times almost every week and made our hospital popular in all the areas located in and around our Hospital.

Others contributed to the Hospital are Lion K Ravikumar who donated two Wooden Cots for the attendants of In patients and a Slotted Angle - 5 Shelf for keeping the medicine boxes.
